

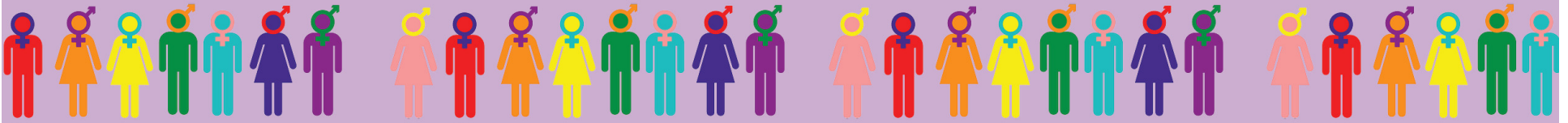

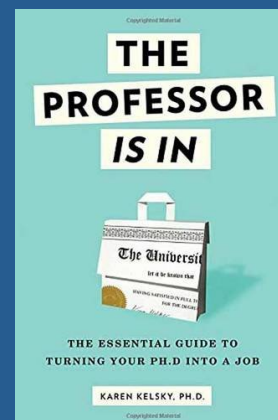


Interested in applying for academic jobs in the field of Women's Studies or other allied fields?
